Name: Retain Healthcare Retiree Benefits for Future UNM Employees

Council Action: Adopted

- 1. WHEREAS healthcare benefits are a vital part of the comprehensive compensation package offered to UNM employees; and,
- 2. WHEREAS a solid compensation package gives UNM a competitive advantage to attract and retain the best and the brightest employees; and,
- 3. WHEREAS maintaining current and prospective employees' faith in the integrity of the compensation package improves retention; and,
- 4. WHEREAS a compensation package is an investment in UNM's human capital.
- 5. Therefore, be it resolved that the Staff Council opposes the elimination of retiree healthcare benefits for any UNM employee, including those hired on or after July 1, 2015.
